Pope Francis has launched a questionnaire ahead of the upcoming October 2018 Synod of Bishops on youth, **and he invites you to take part.** A public consultation is now underway to better understand the lives, attitudes and concerns of young people across the globe. Open to everyone, especially youth and those who closely work with or know young people (13-35 years old), i.e. parents, teachers, etc.. Two surveys are available online for reading and comment: one for the general public, and a second specifically for young people. People from all backgrounds are encouraged to take part, because "every young person has the right to be accompanied without exclusion."
