Highlights:

- **Sanctuary of Betharram**, where for eight centuries, the Virgin has been venerated.
- **Lourdes**, one of the most popular Catholic shrines in the world.
- Pray at the **Grotto**, bathe in the **Miraculous Waters**, or walk the magnificent life sized **Stations of the Cross**
- **Toulouse** – best known today for its central role in the European aerospace industry, also full of religious and historical treasures such as;
- **Basilica of St. Sernin** (Benedictine Abbey), one of the finest Romanesque churches in France
- **Eglise des Jacobins** - St. Thomas Aquinas is buried here
- **Rocamadour** - Spectacular natural and religious site perched high on a rocky plateau. We visit:
- **Shrine of Our Lady of Rocamadour**, a complex of religious structures centered on a **miraculous statue** of the Virgin Mary
- **Chapelle Miraculeuse** contains the Tomb of St. Amador, who is said to have carved out an hermitage in the rock.
- **Paray le Monial**, known across the world thanks to the popularity of the message of the heart of Jesus
- **Apparitions Chapel** where **Saint Margaret-Mary Alacoque** lies in a decorated reliquary; and

- **The sacred Heart Basilica** where John-Paul II came as a pilgrim himself.
- **Ars**, famous through the holy life and labors of **St. John Vianney**, its beloved Curé
- Visit the **Shrine of the Cure's Heart**.
- Through the picturesque French countryside to **Nevers**, to visit the **Bernadette Soubirous Centre**
- Pray **over Incorrupt body of Saint Bernadette**
- **Mass** in the **Chapel**.
- Walk in the **footsteps of Saint Bernadette** around the convent and its grounds.
- **Orleans** that was famously saved by **St. Joan of Arc** from English during the siege in 1429,
- **Chartres** – **Cathedral Notre Dame de Chartres**
- **Evron** to visit the **Religious Community of Saint Martin** and join the evening **Gregorian Chant**
- **Mont Saint Michel** for a guided visit of this unique UNESCO World Heritage site.
- **Lisieux**, home of **St. Theresa, the Little Flower of Jesus**
- Visit all the places related to her life; **Basilica, Carmel Monastery, Les Buissonnets, Saint Peter's Cathedral**.
- **Paris**, with so many beautiful and spiritually rich experiences for the Catholic traveler.
- The **Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal**, a chapel revered as the site of three apparitions of the Virgin Mary in 1830 and the incorrupt body of **St. Catherine Labouré**.
- **Notre Dame Cathedral**, Christ's Crown of thorns held here
- **Basilica of Sacré Coeur**, on **Montmartre**, traditionally associated with the beheading of the city's patron, **Saint Denis**, in the **3rd century**
- **Sainte-Chapelle**, built by Louis IX for use as his royal chapel
- Sightseeing tour including see the **Arc de Triomphe**, and the **Champs Elysée, Eiffel Tower**
- **Free Full Day** to explore on your own in Paris
