Acts 2:1-11

Adults: Does the Holy Spirit seem like a Person to you, as real as Jesus? Why or why not?

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CHURCH IN CHINA – MAY 24

Pope Francis has asked all Catholics to show solidarity through their prayers on Pentecost weekend, for persecuted Christians in China and throughout the world. The World Day of Prayer for the Church in China is observed each year on the feast of Our Lady Help of Christians, May 24, which this year falls on Pentecost. Catholics in China invoke Mary, venerated at the Marian Shrine of Sheshan, near Shanghai, each May 24, the pope noted.

“We, too, will ask Mary to help Catholics in China always to be credible witnesses of this merciful love among their fellow citizens and to live spiritually united to the rock of Peter, upon whom the church is built,” he said.

HOLY SPIRIT HOLES - BUILDING WARDEN'S NIGHTMARE! Ever heard of “Holy Spirit Holes”? In the middle ages, holes were punched in the ceiling & roofs of churches to symbolize an openness to God. On Pentecost, they released doves through these holes and bundles of rose petals were dropped from them onto the people gathered inside. Then the Altar Servers moved through the congregation making whooshing sounds to remind everyone of the rush of the Spirit. We bet some of our Altar Servers would have liked that job! Today is the Feast of Pentecost in which we commemorate the coming of the Holy Spirit on the early followers of Jesus. Before the events of the first Pentecost, which came a few weeks after Jesus' death and resurrection, there were followers of Jesus, but no movement that could be meaningfully called “the church.” So, from an historical point of view, Pentecost is the day on which the church was started. Thankfully we no longer punch holes in the roofs of our churches, but hopefully we will all be open to the power of God's Spirit in our lives as we say, “Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and kindle in them the fire of your love!” Amen.
