

CANONIZATION OF MOTHER TERESA

Next Sunday, September 4, Salt + Light TV will broadcast live from Saint Peter's Square, Rome, the canonization of Blessed Mother Teresa, founder of the Missionaries of Charity. Among the bishops present will be Archbishop Christian Lépine of Montreal. The canonization Mass will be broadcast live at 3:30 am and repeated at 8:00 am, 12:00 pm, 3:30 pm (in French), 8:30 pm and 12:30 am, as well as on Wednesday September 07 at 8:30 pm and 12:30 am.
