Draw me closer to You this summer.

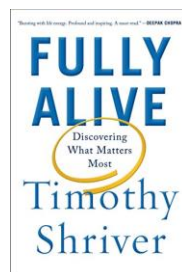
Teach me how I can pray no matter

Fully Alive: Discovering What Matters Most, by Timothy Shriver

In this unusual and gripping memoir, Timothy Shriver shows how his teachers have been the world's most forgotten minority: people with **intellectual disabilities**. Shriver's journey begins close to home, where the quiet legacy of his aunt Rosemary, a **Kennedy** whose intellectual disability kept her far from the limelight, inspired his family to devote their careers to helping the most vulnerable, and led to helping at Camp Shriver, and finally leading **Special Olympics**. *Fully Alive* is both a moving personal journey and a meditation on some of the greatest wisdom and the greatest contradictions of our society. Shriver argues that we all have different **abilities & challenges** we should embrace.
