
### **GREETINGS AND LOVE FROM KERALA, INDIA**

### *Imitating Mary: Ten Marian Virtues for the Modern Mom*, by Marge Fenelon.

With her new book, Marge has once again made holiness seem to be something that is attainable for anyone. She has made a connection between the holiness of the Blessed Mother and the lives of modern mothers everywhere so that we, too, can feel hope that by following the example of Mary, we can live a virtuous life right here and now.

Marge chose ten virtues—yes, patience, trust, obedience, endurance, courage, strength, hope, faith and joy—and laid them out for us with a scriptural background that makes the

story of the Blessed Mother come alive, anecdotes from the author's own life, and some examples of how we, too, can imitate Mary. Then, she leaves us with some thoughts to ponder from the annals of the Church, and some reflection questions.
