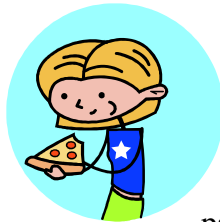


## THANK YOU FROM MS SOCIETY

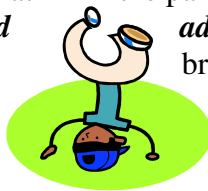
## YOUTH

youth group program at the parish for 11 to 16yr olds. *All parents and adults* who are interested in create a dynamic group are invited

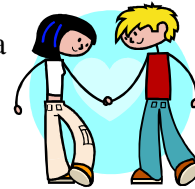

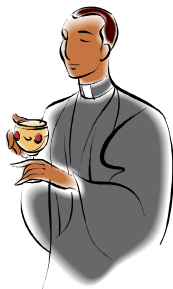
