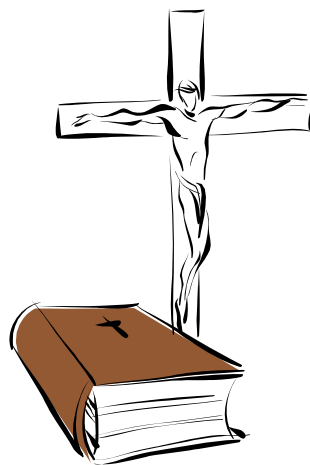

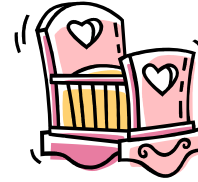


KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS FAMILY BREAKFAST:
