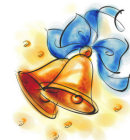

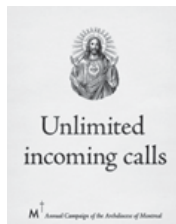
**EVENING OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS TO THE PRIESTHOOD**
