Your donations this year were used to repaint the parking lot lines, install rain gutters, a utility shed, outdoor railing leading to the rectory, and indoor railing beside the ambo. We also discovered that many squirrels and mice had been burrowing in the attics over the rectory and Cahill hall, had stripped away most of the insulation, and chewed through the wiring. We have since "wildlife proofed" and re-insulated the attics and repaired the wiring and air conditioning system in Cahill hall.
