Reading I: Genesis 14:18-20 (Melchizedek)

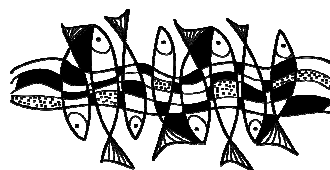
Reading II: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (Do This in Remembrance of Me)

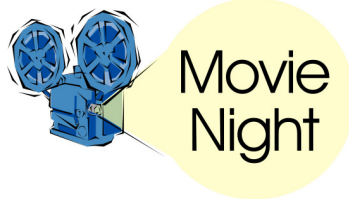

YEAR FOR PRIESTS: The year will conclude in Rome with an international gathering of priests with the Holy Father from June 9-11. The first day will be dedicated to conversion and the mission of priests, 7000 of whom will gather at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. The second day was originally planned for the Basilica of St. Mary Major, but the great number of priests who have registered will not have enough space in the Marian basilica, so the gathering will be held at St. Paul's again. The priests will meet together in a renewed cenacle, as apostles gathered around the Blessed Virgin Mary awaiting the Spirit. The closing Mass on Friday, June 11, will be celebrated by Pope Benedict XVI. Please continue to keep all our priests in your prayers!
