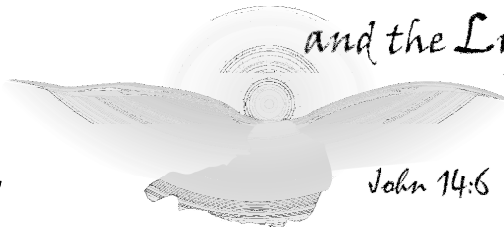

Gospel: John 10:1-10 (I am the Gate)

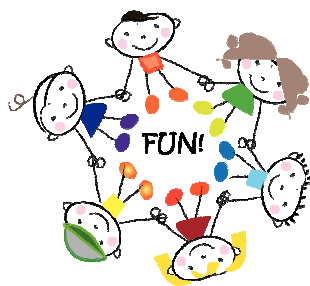
**Adults:** How do I take stock of my life and come to understand my deepest needs and, ultimately, my complete reliance on the Lord?


**WYD 2011 – SPAIN** The next International World Youth Day will be taking in Spain from August 16-21. The theme is “Planted and built up in Jesus Christ, Firm in the Faith”. Although international WYD is celebrated every 2-3 years it is celebrated on a Diocesan level every Palm Sunday. Blessed John Paul II initiated this event that celebrates the youth of the world and our Catholic faith. It has taken place in the Philippines, Italy (3 times), Germany, Spain (once) Poland, Argentina, Australia, the U.S, France and of course Canada.
