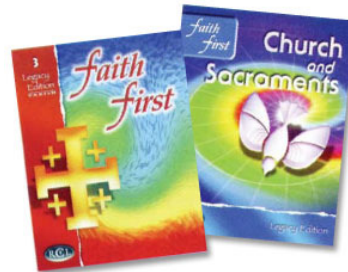

First Reading: Zechariah 9: 9-10 (Your King Comes)

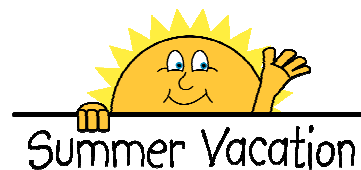
Second Reading: Romans 8: 9, 11-13 (The Spirit Helps)

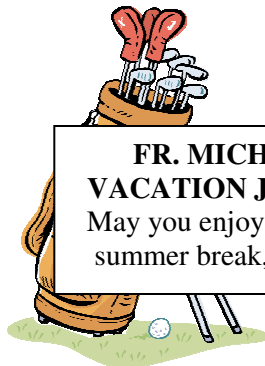
BLESSNG OF THE PETS All pets and their humans are asked to come to the apron on **July 3, at 1:30 p.m.**, for our annual blessing of the pets.

LOW-GLUTEN ALTAR BREADS FOR CELIACS: Please note that all Celiacs may receive the Body Of Christ at every Mass at Becket in the form of low-gluten hosts. These special hosts are made according to the requirements of both the Code of Canon Law (c.924) and the special considerations set out by the Prefect for the Congregation for the Doctrine of Faith, in a July 24, 2003 letter to the Presidents of Episcopal Conferences (Prot. N. 89/78-17498), and may be validly used at Mass. Our low gluten bread is made with wheat starch and water. The gluten content is 0.01%. These hosts are made, shipped, and stored in a dedicated gluten-free environment. At communion, please proceed to the left side of the church (tabernacle side) **and remain at the foot of the sanctuary near the railing.** A Eucharistic minister will meet you to distribute low-gluten hosts.
