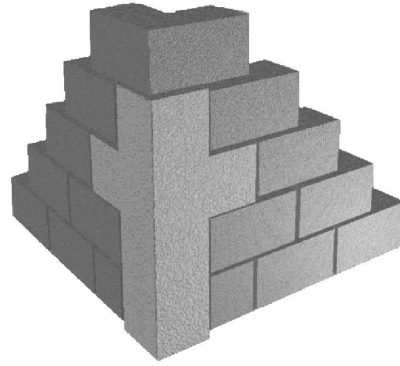

## FAITH FIRST

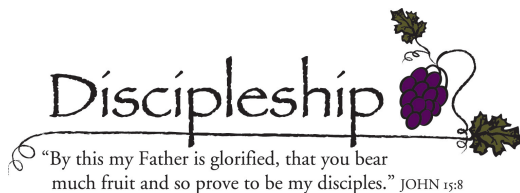

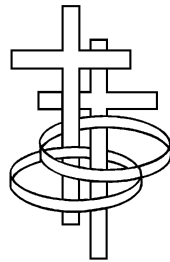
