EUTHANSIA - THE CCCB RESPONDS: The Bishops of Canada have sent a submission to the Expert Panel on Options for a Legislative Response to Carter v. Canada. The Carter v. Canada (AG) case struck down federal laws that prohibit assisting someone to commit suicide. The federal government now has until Feb. 2016 to introduce legislation to regulate when and how assisted suicide can be legally practised.
