CONFESSIONS OF A CHURCH CARPENTER: For the comfort and protection of the priest and penitent, some churches have installed windows in their confessionals. As our confessionals allow for face to face confession, we have installed a small, doubled-paned smoked glass window in the left-side confessional. We have also installed traditional lights so that penitents will know if the confessional is occupied. The green light indicates that the priest is available. The red light means a penitent is in the confessional.

(Act Respecting Fabriques). A warden is a parishioner elected to be a director, or administrator, of the church corporation whose object is to acquire, possess, hold and administer property for the practice of the Roman Catholic religion. Therefore the warden is not a pastoral agent directing the spiritual and pastoral life of the parish. Professional or business experience and ability to work in a team are assets.
