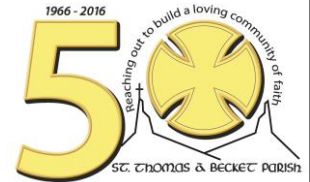
BOWSER & BLUE are coming to Becket April 8th. Tickets are available on-line at www.becket.ca or at 514-915-7586.
