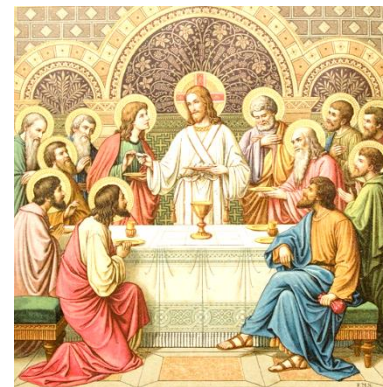

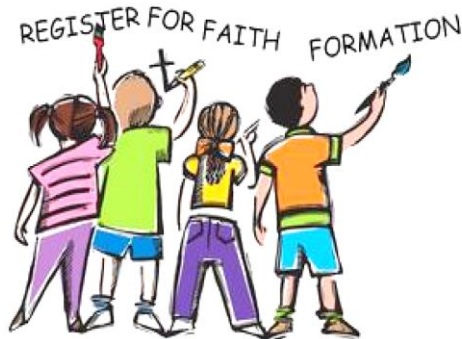
THANK YOU FROM FR. PETER

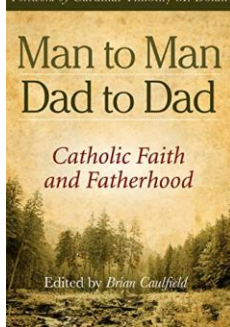


DON'T BE A VICTIM
