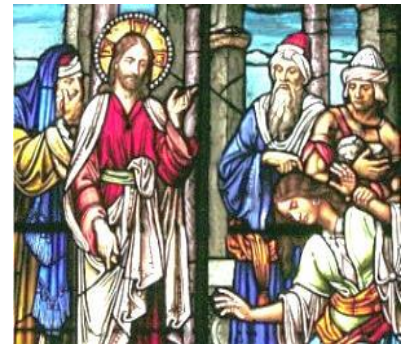

PRAYING IN ADORATION

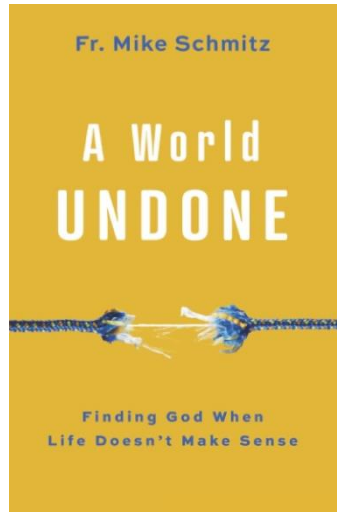
