RESPONSIBLE PASTORAL MINISTRY



It was on June 7, 2016, that Archbishop Christian Lépine signed the decree establishing the policy to ensure a safe and healthy environment for all and to counter all forms of abuse within the Archdiocese of Montreal.

To date, 136 parishes, including St. Thomas à Becket, have a designated coordinator to lead the Responsible Pastoral Ministry.

Here at St. Thomas à Becket, over 140 volunteers and staff have begun completing the necessary forms, with many already completed.
