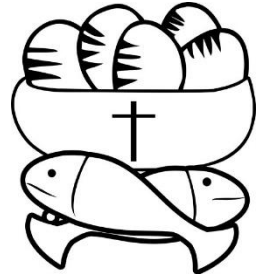

## RESPONSIBLE PASTORAL MINISTRY



It was on June 7, 2016, that Archbishop Christian Lépine signed the decree establishing the policy to ensure a safe and healthy environment for all and to counter all forms of abuse within the Archdiocese of Montreal. To date, 136 parishes, including St. Thomas à Becket, have a

designated coordinator to lead the Responsible Pastoral Ministry.

Here at St. Thomas à Becket, over 140 volunteers and staff have begun completing the necessary forms, with many already completed.

## SAINT ANNE – PATRONESS OF QUÉBEC– Feast Day July 26



Settlers, missionaries, and sailors coming from France brought devotion to Saint Anne to North America, where it was widely accepted, especially at Sainte-Anne-de-Baupré, where pilgrims have shown their devotion to Saint Anne for over 350 years. Saint Anne was proclaimed the patroness of Québec in 1876.

Even if we know very little about the life of Saint Anne, as the mother of Mary and the grandmother of Jesus, she has been venerated by Catholics around the world for centuries.

Both Saint Anne and Saint Joachim serve as role models for parents, and both deserve to be honoured and emulated for their devotion to God and Our Lady Mary, the Mother of God.
