DIVINE MERCY RETREAT – ST-LUC PARISH



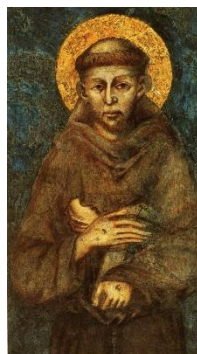
