

The Greatest Gift of All Ornament

Fun craft to make with your children.
The Greatest Gift of All Ornament to remind your children of the manger scene.

Materials needed:

- A clear plastic cup
- A piece of cardboard cut into a circle to put on the bottom of the cup or a plastic lid.
If using a lid; cut a round piece of brown construction paper to fit inside the cup lid for the floor
- Gold pipe cleaner fits nicely around the lip of the lid at the end
- Pieces of cut up paper bags for the hay
- Manger: small folded box using brown construction paper. Small matchboxes work well too
- Tissue paper to line the inside of the manger



- A round wooden ball for the baby's head.
- Popsicle stick cut to about 1 inch. Use a glue gun to glue the ball and for wrapping the yarn
- Yarn to make the baby's body
- Dark Blue card stock cut out to fit in the cup, you can add stars
- The "Greatest Gift of All" glues nicely on bottom of manger
- Yarn or Pipe cleaner to hang the ornament on the tree
