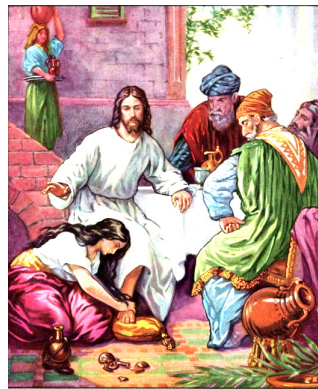

49TH INTERNATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS:

The purpose of Eucharistic Congresses is to make known more and more, to love and to serve Our Lord Jesus Christ in

the Blessed Sacrament of the altar, by periodical and solemn celebrations while working to extend His social reign in the whole world. At each Congress this purpose is pursued in two ways: 1) by prayers, communions, adoration, solemn homage given to the King of Kings and especially by a final homage that should be a public action, very demonstrative and as much as possible national in reparation and in love towards the Blessed Sacrament; 2) through sessions to study the best way to proceed to revive and spread devotion to the Holy Eucharist under all forms authorized by the Church.
