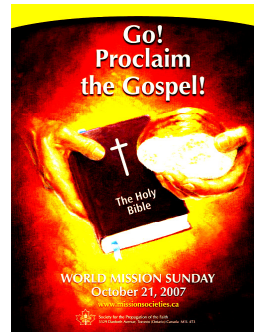

It follows that the universal Church and each individual Church is sent forth to the nations...to proclaim the Gospel all over the world."*
