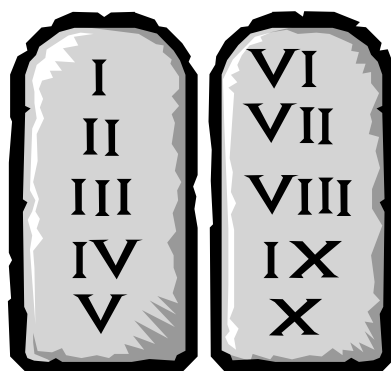

CHURCH ROOF CONSTRUCTION BEGINS NEXT WEEK! Next Thursday, May 1st, the roofers will come to the church to begin construction of our new roof. They will start by dropping off their equipment and setting up scaffolding. By May 5th, construction will begin on the Narthex. The process will involve stripping away the old roof, then replacing with the new roof, section by section, including the narthex, church, hall, Cahill hall, and rectory. Mill deck repairs will be part of the process, especially over the church hall. The scaffolding will be moved around the building as required for each section. The roofers will be in contact with us daily to make sure they work around our schedule, right through to the end of the summer. Please note that if you find the Main church entrance (Narthex) inaccessible, the church hall entrance and the rectory entrances will be open.

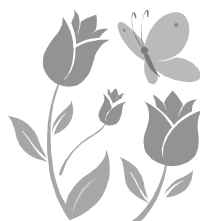
