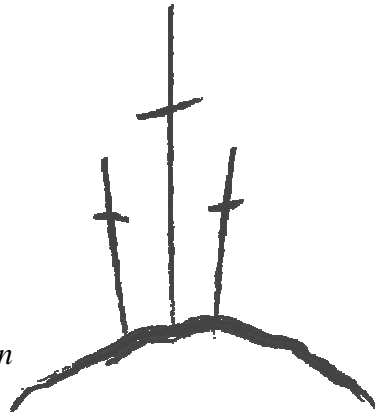

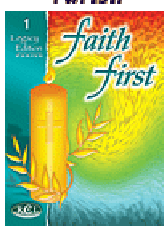

Did you know... Becket has over 600 children enrolled in our faith education program (Faith First)? We also offer R.C.I.A. for adults requesting baptism, Eucharist, full Communion or Confirmation; Children's Liturgy during weekend Masses; Prayer groups and Bible Study groups; Day CAFÉ (Catholic Adult Faith Education), an off-shoot of our Faith First Parent gatherings, which is now open to all adults in the parish. These many catechetical processes highlight the living strength of our Christian community at Becket. Let us continue to unite in prayer and commitment!

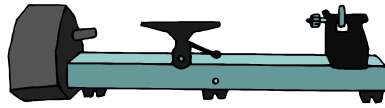


AN INVITATION TO: “THE MARRIAGE COURSE”
