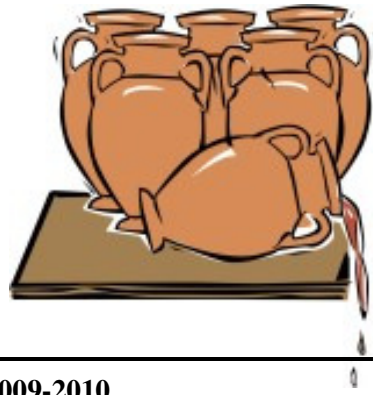

THE 96TH WORLD DAY OF MIGRANTS AND REFUGEES: JANUARY 17, 2010

“...I was a stranger and you welcomed me” (Mt 25:36)

The theme for the 2010 World Day of Migrants and Refugees is *Minor migrants and refugees* - protecting the rights of children who are migrants and refugees. Children comprise approximately half of the world's refugee population. Many of these children become orphans and suffer physical and emotional traumas that scar them for life. Armed conflict is the main driving force in the displacement of refugee populations—child or adult. For us as Christians, it is essential to recall that all human beings, regardless of the labels given to them, are entitled to full respect of their human dignity and rights; we are challenged by the Gospels to respond to all ‘dispossessed’ people, extend hospitality, and work for justice.

In his annual message, the Holy Father Pope Benedict invites all Christians to become aware of the “social and pastoral challenges”: *“I now turn in particular to parishes and to the many Catholic associations which, imbued with a spirit of faith and charity, take pains to meet the needs of these brothers and sisters of ours. While I express gratitude for all that is being done with great generosity, I would like to invite all Christians to become aware of the social and pastoral challenges posed by migrant and refugee minors.”* Visit www.vatican.va for the complete message.
