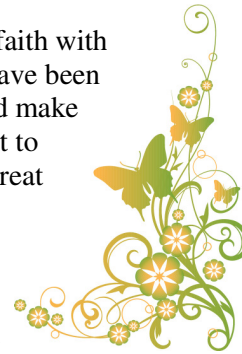
FAITH FIRST
