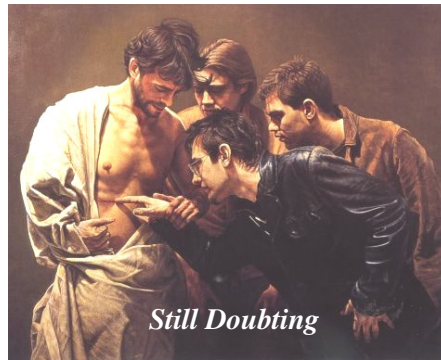

**THERE IS A CONNECTION** between the image and the liturgy of the second Sunday of Easter, the feast of the Divine Mercy. Today's gospel account from St. John describes the Risen Christ appearing to the apostles in the upper room and the institution of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The rays of blood and water flowing from Our Savior's pierced heart and the scars on His hands and feet recall the events of Good Friday. The pale ray represents water which purifies souls, while the red ray stands for the blood, which is the life of souls.

It is the sacrament of Baptism and the Sacrament of Reconciliation that purify the soul and the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist that most fully nourishes it. Thus, the two rays signify the sacraments and all the gifts of the Holy Spirit of which water is a symbol in Scripture.
