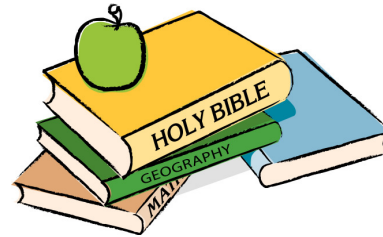

CELEBRATE BLESSED MARIE-ROSE

DUROCHER: In honour of the 200th anniversary of the birth of their foundress, Eulalie Durocher, the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary are preparing some grand celebrations to mark this event this fall. Eulalie Durocher, Mother Marie-Rose, who was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1982, was born in Quebec, on October 6. A woman of faith and of action, Blessed Marie-Rose Durocher responded to the faith education needs of her time, especially for those who were poor or disadvantaged. She is a wonderful model for us. Throughout the years

Sisters continued her work in many schools including St. John Fisher, St. Edmund, Holy Names High, Vincent Massey, JFK, and St. Thomas High.
