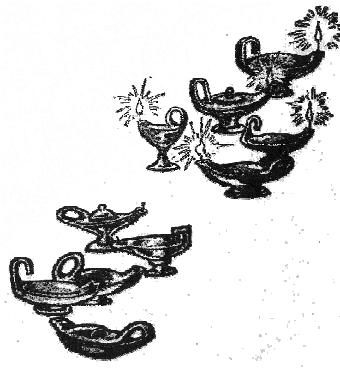

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL AGM AND ELECTIONS will be held on **November 13, in the parish hall after the 11:00 a.m. Mass.** The Pastoral Council plays a *consultative* role and functions as an advisory board to the Pastor by studying and reflecting on parish issues (worship, education, evangelization, stewardship, etc.) and then recommending conclusions. We pray and work together to discern the will of God on how best to serve the parish. Elected PPC members serve three-year terms on a rotational basis. Three positions must be filled at the AGM on **November 13**. Please consider running for a position on our council. Nomination forms are available at the back of the church.



ROMAN MISSAL: On **November 08, 15 & 22, at 7:30 pm**, we will be offering three catechetical sessions about the new translation of the Roman Missal. These evenings are designed to help parishioners learn the new prayers of the new Mass, and

will include video and music presentations as well as Q & A sessions. Together, we will renew our love for the Sacred Liturgy, learn about and understand the changes, and develop an appreciation for the revised translation. Together with all English-speaking Roman Catholics throughout Canada, we will begin to celebrate Mass with the new translation on the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011.

“MOVEMBER” Fr. Mike Leclerc will participate in this year’s Movember campaign to raise funds and awareness for prostate cancer.
