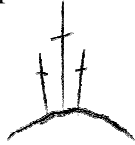

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS: The American Civil Liberties Union has announced that they have won a law suit against the Knights of Columbus, who must now allow women to join the world's largest Roman Catholic fraternal service organization. The Supreme Council of the K. of C. will appeal the case.

THE CCCB has recently announced that Pope Benedict the XVI will create a Penal Ordinariate in Canada. Like the Canadian Military Ordinariate, the Penal Ordinariate will be immediately subject to the Holy See, and will provide for the spiritual and religious needs of Catholic inmates in our nation's prisons, as well as for other inmates seeking to know about the Catholic faith and way of life. The offices will be located in the Kingston Penitentiary in Ontario.

NEW CANONICAL STRUCTURE FOR ANGLICANS BECOMING CATHOLIC: The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith released a note about Personal Ordinariates for Anglicans entering the Catholic Church. The New Rite does not require a Profession of Faith; converts must simply pass a physical fitness and mental competency test.
