**EARTH DAY APRIL 22:** On January 9, 2012 Pope Benedict XVI addressed the recent natural and ecological disasters and the importance of cooperation on the issue of environmental quality in the 2012 message to the Vatican’s diplomatic corps.

*“We cannot disregard the grave natural calamities which in 2011 affected various regions of South-East Asia, or ecological disasters like that of the Fukushima nuclear plant in Japan. Environmental protection and the connection between fighting poverty and fighting climate change are important areas for the promotion of integral human development. For this reason, I hope that...the international community will prepare for the UN Conference on Sustainable Development (‘Rio + 20’) as an authentic ‘family of nations’ and thus with a great sense of solidarity and responsibility towards present and future generations.”*
