TODAY IS THE 49TH WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS.

Jesus told His Disciples, "I came to serve, not to be served." A vocation is a call to serve. It is a profession, an urge, a predisposition to undertake a certain kind of work. It is a choice for which you are particularly suited. The central question always is, "How best can I serve God and others?" If you feel a calling to the married life, there are many Church ministries from which to choose. Many are in need of your service, as a deacon, a Eucharistic minister, a visitor to the sick and aged, or an usher. Whatever you choose, do something that serves others. When you do this, you are serving God. If you feel a calling to priesthood or religious life, ask questions and talk to priests or religious. They can help you come to know your vocation or career, your special calling. Above all, start with prayer. Whatever your vocation, if you are good at what you do, it is a gift from God. Only through prayer will you be able to recognize what vocation gift He wants to give to you.

The Holy Father's Message, on the theme "Vocations, the Gift of the Love of God," is available at www.vatican.va. In his message, Pope Benedict XVI expresses the hope that the local Churches and all the various groups within them will become places where vocations are carefully discerned and their authenticity tested, places where young men and women are offered wise and strong spiritual direction. In this way, the Christian community itself becomes a manifestation of the Love of God in which every calling is contained.
