## QUESTION OF THE WEEK

This Is My Body

First Reading: Exodus 24: 368 (Covenant of Blood)

Second Reading: Hebrews 9: 11615 (Christ's Blood)

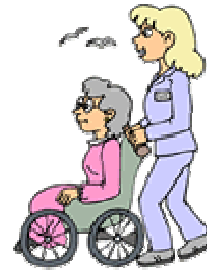
Gospel: Mark 14:12616, 22626 (This is my Blood)

**Adults:** Do I see the Eucharist simply as an obligation or as a means of life?

**Children:** Do I remember that Jesus comes to me every time at Mass and that I can ask him for anything I need?

**OPEN HEARTS OPEN MINDS, OPEN DOORS:** Did you know? One out of seven Canadians has a disability – physical, mental or sensory. At Becket we are slowly working to improve our accessibility for everyone. We have exterior parking for the handicapped, as well as a wheelchair ramp and a reserved section in the church for those in a chair. A few years ago, we removed a whole pew at the very front, left hand (tabernacle side) of the church in front of the first pew, so that those in chairs could simply park and pray. No need to get out of your chair! In addition, we have a fully accessible, wheel-chair friendly washroom in the parish hall.

Don't be afraid to help those with reduced mobility or other disabilities. Some of our parishioners need help getting out of their car, opening the church doors, or finding the reserved section for chairs. Treat people with disabilities as you would anyone else. Offer assistance and then wait for the offer to be accepted. Do not impose if help is not desired. Try to place yourself at eye level when addressing someone in a chair. After identifying yourself, give your whole, unhurried attention to any person who has difficulty speaking or hearing. Offer to read this weekly bulletin to someone who is blind. Celebrate Access!!
