I take care of the environment. **Justin S.**

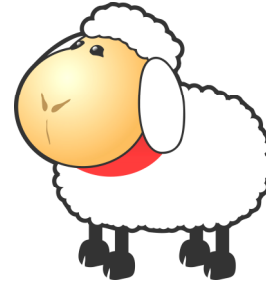

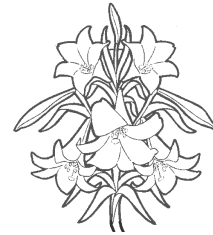
