FABRIQUE AND H.O. COMMITTEE ELECTIONS DEC. 08, 2013, 12 PM
All parishioners are invited to the election of Churchwardens and Helping Others Committee members on Dec. 08 after the 11 a.m. Mass. Churchwardens assist the parish priest in the administration of the parish. All parishioners of full age (18yrs), of the Roman Catholic Faith, and who live within the parish boundaries are entitled to nominate, be nominated, and vote at the Meeting of Parishioners. (Act Respecting Fabriques). There are a total of six churchwarden positions with terms of three years. Two Churchwarden positions must be filled at this election. The Helping Others Committee manages our charitable outreach programs under the authority of the Fabrique: There are four elected Helping Others Committee members; the term of office is two years. Two positions must be filled Dec. 08.
