

ANNUAL CAMPAIGN – CATHOLIC CHURCH OF MONTREAL

Every spring, the Church of Montreal has an Annual Collection to support the Church's undertakings. Through the steadfast generosity of the faithful, we raised over 1.5 million dollars last year. Following is how the money is used:

- *Passing Down a Heritage project.* The work of this project is to benefit not only the stones of our church walls, but even more so, the living stones of our Church. In order for our communities to develop, our real estate assets must be maintained. All of these places of worship are also places of gathering and community life where faith, sharing, and charity may flourish. Our current flagship project is the revitalization of Saint-Nom-de-Jésus Parish in Hochelaga-Maisonneuve.
- The inauguration of *Notre-Dame de la Rue*, which opens its doors to the homeless and offers them spiritual support, something that is not offered by any other charitable organization in Montreal.
- Lobbying against the passage of Bill 52 on end-of-life care, which we believe would facilitate euthanasia. We will be following this debate closely as it evolves.
- Partaking in the celebration in the Archdiocese of Quebec's joy as it celebrated their pastor's elevation to cardinal in February.

The success of these projects relies heavily on the generosity of many. The Church is counting on you again this year, so that we may always be increasingly dynamic in the proclamation of the Good News of Jesus Christ. Donation envelopes are available in the pews.

THIS YEAR'S CORPUS CHRISTI CELEBRATION will take place on **Thursday, June 19 at 7:30pm**, beginning with Mass at Mary Queen of the World Cathedral, followed by the Eucharistic Procession to St. Patrick's Basilica for Benediction.
