ALL SOULS DAY, or the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, is celebrated in early November, when the sun seems to fade, evenings become cold and dark, and nature reclaims her bounty. We are also approaching the end of the liturgical year, when scripture focuses on end times, the judgement of God, and the coming of Christ as Lord of All. This year, All Souls Day falls on a Sunday, and gives us a special opportunity to focus on the mystery of Christian death. While the focus of this celebration remains on Christ, on his death and resurrection; we are invited to remember our departed loved ones insofar as they participate in the death and rising of Jesus Christ. All parishioners, families and friends are invited to join us as we celebrate the Mass of All Souls on **Saturday, November 1 at 4:30 pm, and Sunday, November 2, 9:00 am and 11:00 am.** All are invited to bring a photo of their deceased loved one(s) to be placed below the altar during the Mass.
