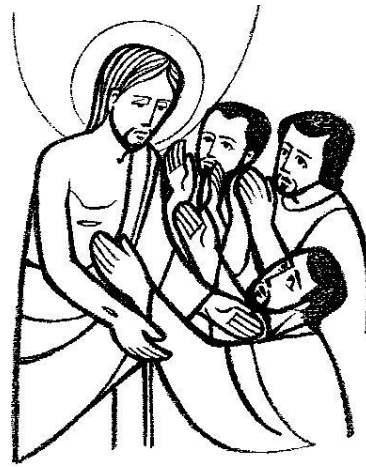

DIVINE MERCY NEWS! During a Lenten penitential homily, Pope Francis announced an extraordinary Jubilee which will be dedicated to a theme close to the pontiff's heart: mercy. The Jubilee, also called a Holy Year, will begin Dec. 8, 2015, and will end Nov. 20, 2016. In his first Angelus address as the Bishop of Rome, March 17, 2013, Pope Francis said, "Mercy is the best thing we can feel: it changes the world. A little mercy makes the world less cold and more just. We need to understand properly this mercy of God, this merciful Father who is so patient." In the English version of his first Apostolic Exhortation "Evangelii Gaudium," the word "mercy" appears 32 times.
