If you are not available for an entire hour, please feel free to drop by anytime during these hours, even if it just to spend a few moments with Our Lord.

WHAT IS EUCHARISTIC ADORATION? Eucharistic Adoration is the adoration of Jesus Christ present in the Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist is displayed on the altar in a special holder called a monstrance. Throughout the day, people come to pray and worship Jesus. Christ's great love for us was shown when he was crucified on the cross to pay the penalty for our sins and give us eternal life. He loves us without limit, and offers Himself to us in the Holy sacrament of the Eucharist. During Eucharistic Adoration, we "watch and wait", we remain "silent" in His Presence, and open ourselves to His Graces, which flow from the Eucharist ... By worshipping the Eucharistic Jesus, we become what God wants us to be! Like a magnet, the Lord draws us to Himself and gently transforms us. In its fullest essence ... Eucharistic Adoration is "God and Man reaching out for each other, at the same time!"
