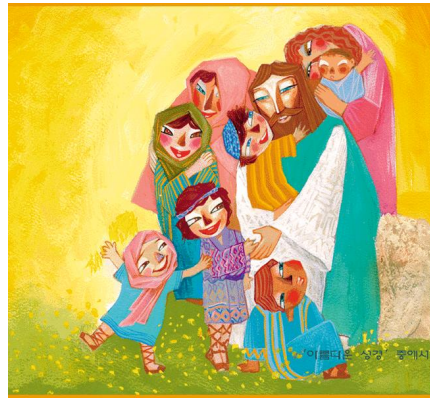

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Wisdom 2:12, 17-20

James 3:16-4:3

Mark 9:30-37

Adults: We all grapple with the human tendency to attack and reject those who “oppose our actions”. Yet, as Jesus predicts His betrayal, suffering and death, He demonstrates gentleness and patience. When faced with adversity or injustice, how do my own actions emulate Our Lord’s?

Youth: Why do you think a person who always does what is right may be resented by others? How do you think sarcasm and insults affect those who are trying to do the right thing? How would you describe the example Jesus the Just One gives us? Name one way you will try to follow that example.

Children: How many qualities of wisdom from above does James name? What are they? What is his answer to the question about where conflicts and disputes begin? Find the statement in which James points to the connection between peace and justice. How do you, your family, or your friends cultivate peace?
