EUTHANSIA - THE CCCB RESPONDS: The Bishops of Canada have sent a submission to the Expert Panel on Options for a Legislative Response to Carter v. Canada. The Carter v. The federal government now has until Feb. 2016 to introduce legislation to regulate when and how assisted suicide can be legally practised.
