
Thank you for welcoming us and for your generous collaboration. May God bless you all and grant you health and a nice summer. We keep you in our prayers.

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY...

...to all fathers in the parish: The following article by Chris Erickson is our gift to you.

Fathers, you are 'the first heralds of the faith' for your children (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1656, 2225). The 'first evangelization' begins in your own heart, and when it takes root it becomes contagious within your family!

Pope John Paul II wrote: 'The history of mankind, the history of salvation, passes by way of the family . . . the family is placed at the centre of the great struggle between good and evil, between life and death, between love and all that is opposed to love. To the family is entrusted the task of striving, first and foremost, to unleash the forces of good, the source of which is found in Christ the Redeemer of man.'

"Fathers, you are called to unleash your children as 'forces of good' upon the world. By making the following eight habits your own, you will be well on your way to attaining this goal."

8 Habits of Highly Effective Catholic Fathers

1. Educate yourself in the faith
2. Put what you learn into practice.
3. Teach Christ's truths personally.
4. Pray together.
5. Spend time with your children.
6. Keep a careful check over harmful media influences
7. Be vigilant over your children's friends.
8. Make your home a place of tranquillity and peace—beginning with loving your wife.



St. John Chrysostom said the home should be a 'little church,' a miniature kingdom of God. Is your home too stern, too demanding on the children? Or, are there few rules and little enforcement? Is dad too busy and mom often irritable (or vice versa)? Value honesty and hard work, offer love, admit mistakes, ask forgiveness, and laugh much. Adorn your home with reminders of your Christian faith: a crucifix, holy pictures or statues bring to mind events in the life of Our Lord.

O Eternal Father, You have given us the gift of fathers. Look in love upon those we call father. Protect and keep them from all harm; prosper and bless them in all good things; comfort them when they are lonely or afraid, and let no misunderstanding come between them and us to divide our hearts. Bless and reward our fathers whom You have called home to Yourself. Reward them for their efforts, love, and dedication in being a father to their family. Amen. Saint Joseph, foster-father of Jesus, be a model and source of inspiration to all fathers. Amen.
