Never Give Up: My Life and God's Mercy, by John Janaro, St. Anthony Messenger Press, 2010.

This book is a blessing for those who suffer from debilitating illness and the important people in their lives. The author is a family man and professional writer and teacher who battles the ongoing effects of Lyme disease, chronic depression, and obsessive/compulsive disorder. Although the book is filled with examples of spiritual challenges and comforts derived from deep trust in God's mercy, it does not shy away from human tendencies toward bitterness, self-pity, and a "Why me?" attitude. If you're thinking of retreating into your private world of pain—or if you know someone who has—*Never Give Up* will help you see how God's fidelity, the small wonders of daily life, a dose of humor, and the simple kindness of others can bring light into the darkness. *Never Give Up* contains a mix of personal stories and practical suggestions for reliance on God's mercy and love to deal with the effects of debilitating illness.
