

Male, Female, Other?: A Catholic Guide to Understanding Gender, by Jason Evert

Few words today generate as much controversy as "gender." In *Male, Female, Other?*, Jason Evert addresses the most common claims of gender theory and shows how to respond with charity and clarity. To help you understand this issue that is in the news every day, this book answers these questions:

How many genders are there? What if my daughter says she's trans? Do some people have an intersex brain? Should I use their

preferred pronouns? Is gender a social construct? Does surgery prevent suicide? Are puberty blockers safe? What if I experience gender dysphoria?

Jason Evert has traveled to six continents to bring the message of chastity to more than one million people over the past 20 years, including World Youth Days in Australia, Panama, Spain, and Poland. Jason earned a master's degree in Theology, and undergraduate degrees in Counseling and Theology, with a minor in Philosophy at Franciscan University of Steubenville.

He is a best-selling author of more than fifteen books, including The Dating Blueprint, Saint John Paul the Great, How to Find Your Soulmate without Losing Your Soul, and the curriculum YOU: Life, Love, and the Theology of the Body. He and his wife Crystalina are frequent guests on radio programs throughout the country, and their television appearances include MSNBC, Fox News, the BBC, and EWTN. Together, they run chastityproject.com and lead an international alliance of young people who promote purity in more than 40 countries.

MEMORIAL OF ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI: OCTOBER 4



Francesco Bernardone was born in 1181 at Assisi, Umbria, Italy. The son of a wealthy cloth merchant, he lived a lavish and irresponsible life. At twenty, he went to war against Perugia, but was captured and imprisoned. During his imprisonment he experienced a vision from Christ and changed his life completely. He left all his possessions and embraced complete poverty, taking the Gospel as his rule of life. He began to attract followers, and in

1209 with papal blessing he founded the Friars Minor (Franciscans). On the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross on September 14, Saint Francis received in his hands, feet and side the Sacred Wounds from Our Lord's own body. He was canonized by Gregory IX less than two years after his death in 1226, and is perhaps the most-beloved saint in the Church. St. Francis is the patron saint of animals and of ecology.

FEAST OF THE GUARDIAN ANGELS, OCTOBER 2



Those angels charged with the protection and defence of human souls are called Guardian Angels. Faith and tradition tell us that each individual in time has a Guardian Angel who watches over him throughout the whole course of his life and rejoices with him when he reaches Heaven.

Guardian Angels work unceasingly to preserve us from sin and the occasions of sin. They cannot

interfere with or over-ride our free will, but their prayers and spiritual action serve to point out the good choices whenever the occasion arises. They can prod our conscience to become better informed, can offer us strength in the face of temptation, suggest good thought and holy desires, offer our prayers to God, and above all, lead us to Heaven at the hour of our death. If we fall, they help us rise again, gifted with patience and love, they never give up.

Angel of God, my guardian dear, Through whom God's love protects me here; Ever this day be at my side, To light and guard, to rule and guide.
