Therefore, the warden is not a pastoral agent directing the spiritual and pastoral life of the parish. Professional or business experience and the ability to work in a team are assets. We need to elect two wardens on November 30. We thank outgoing wardens Frank Vissani and Michael Randall for their hard work and dedication during their terms.
