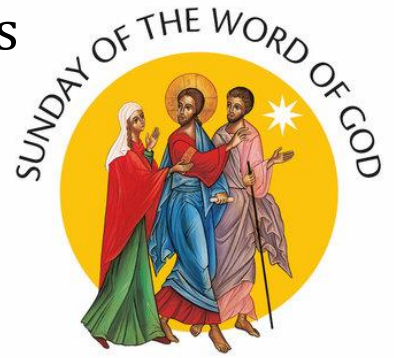

WHY A "SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD"?

January 25 is Sunday of the Word of God. A fair question arises: "Isn't every Sunday a Sunday of the Word of God? Don't we hear the Scriptures every time we gather for Mass?" The answer is a resounding yes.

However, Pope Francis instituted this special day not because the Word is missing on other Sundays, but because we often treat it as "background noise" rather than a living encounter.

In today's Gospel (Matthew 4:12-23), we see the Word of God in action. Jesus doesn't just hand out a pamphlet; He speaks, and His voice is so compelling that Peter, Andrew, James, and John "immediately left their nets" to follow Him.

Most of us own a Bible, but many of us treat it like a reference book rather than a daily companion. Today is a "wake-up call" to open the Book at home, not just hear it in the pews.

Isaiah reminds us that "the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light." In a world filled with confusing headlines and personal anxieties, the Word of God is that light. It is the "map" that makes sense of our lives.

To celebrate this day, don't just leave your Bible on the shelf. Pick one of today's readings and read the entire chapter it comes from to see the full context of God's message.

Like the fishermen at Galilee, ask yourself: "What is the Lord asking me to 'leave behind' this year so I can follow Him more closely?"
