St. Kateri Tekakwitha – Feast Day April 17

Kateri Tekakwitha was born in 1656 to a Mohawk father and an Algonquin mother. At a very young age she contracted smallpox which disfigured her and left her nearly blind. Jesuit missionaries settled in the area shortly thereafter and established a mission. She became friends with them. Curious, she then learned more about Christian spirituality, which resonated with certain aspects of her own. At the age of 20, she was baptized and practiced her faith in an exemplary manner: she prayed to God deep in the forest, as her people did, and strove to remain faithful to the love taught by the Gospel. She died at the age of 24 after a long illness. Since 1972 she has been buried in St. Francis Xavier Church in Kahnawake. Beatified in 1980, Kateri was officially recognized in 2012 as the first Indigenous saint of North America and thus became the patron saint of the environment and of Indigenous Peoples.

10TH ANNIVERSARY OF POPE FRANCIS' AMORIS LAETITIA



We thank the Lord for families who, despite difficulties and challenges, live “the spirituality of family love [...] made up of thousands of small but real gestures” (*AL* 315). I also express my gratitude to the pastors, pastoral workers, Associations of the faithful and ecclesial Movements that are engaged in family ministry. Our era is marked by rapid changes which make it necessary, even more than ten years ago, to give particular pastoral attention to families, to whom the Lord entrusts the task of participating in the Church's mission of proclaiming and witnessing to the Gospel.^[6] There are, in fact, places and circumstances in which the Church “can become the salt of the earth”^[7] only through the lay faithful and, in particular, through families. For this reason, the Church's commitment in this area must be renewed and deepened, so that those whom the Lord calls to marriage and family life can, in Christ, fully live out their conjugal love, and that young people may feel attracted, within the Church, to the beauty of the vocation to marriage. *A reflection by Pope Leo XIV*
